Dog Park Rules
September 11, 2013

Park Hours – Sunrise to Sunset

Dog owners or other persons bringing dogs into the park are liable for damages, injury, or illness your dog(s) may cause to itself or to other dogs or to people. All who enter the dog park do so at their own risk.

Dogs must be on leash when outside the park. Leashes should be removed in the entry area, before entering the small or big enclosures.

Dogs must be under voice control, in the sight of the owner, and never left unattended.

Dog owners must carry a leash at all times.

Dogs must wear collars, preferably with flat, quick release buckles. Identification tags with current vaccination information must be attached to collars.

Choke chains, prong, or spiked collars are not permitted.

Dogs exhibiting aggressive behavior toward people or other dogs must be removed from the park immediately.

Owners **must** pick up after their dogs. Bags for this purpose are provided.

Dogs in heat are prohibited. Spayed/Neutered animals recommended.

Puppies under (4) four months are not allowed in the park.

Children under 13 years of age must be under adult supervision and must be closely supervised at all times. Running, chasing dogs, and playing on the agility equipment is not allowed.

Rawhides, food(dog or human) and glass bottles are not permitted in the dog park.

No smoking, food, or alcohol are permitted in the park.
